About Dublin Castle



Since its foundation in 1204 Dublin Castle has been at the heart of the history and evolution of the city. Guests will explore Chapel Royal, the Chester Beatty Library, the Garda Museum and the Revenue Museum.

About St. Patrick Cathedral



The parish church of Saint Patrick on this site was granted collegiate status in 1191, and raised to cathedral status in 1224. Built in honour of Ireland's patron saint, Saint Patrick's Cathedral stands adjacent to the famous well where tradition has it Saint Patrick baptised converts on his visit to Dublin.

Lunch in Brazen Head



The Brazen Head is officially Ireland's oldest pub, dating back to 1198. While it is unclear how much of the original 11th century coach house is still intact, there is a palpable sense of history within these timeworn walls. If you are looking for the true Irish pub experience then the Brazen Head Pub should be your first port of call.

Powerscourt House and Gardens

Powerscourt Waterfall



Powerscourt Waterfall is Ireland's highest at 121m (398ft.) and is 5km from the Main Estate. It is set in one of Ireland's most beautiful parklands at the foothills of the Wicklow Mountains. As you drive from the gatelodge towards the Waterfall you are surrounded by Beech, Oak, Larch and Pine trees some of which were planted over 200 years ago.
